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| SECTION 1 — INTRODUCTION & COMPANY PROFILE

1.1 WHO WE ARE

American Defense Logistics Group LLC (ADLG) is a registered company in the state of New Mexico, United States, dedicated to serving as a specialized intermediary and authorized reseller of tactical, logistical, and defense products for the federal contracting market. Our mission is to simplify the supply chain between certified manufacturers and U.S. federal government agencies.

ADLG operates under a reseller/intermediary model, meaning we do not manufacture products directly. Instead, we acquire products from previously verified manufacturers and distributors that comply with all applicable federal regulatory frameworks, including NDAA, TAA, Berry Amendment, and the Buy American Act.

1.2 BUSINESS MODEL

- **Verified Sourcing:** We work exclusively with manufacturers and distributors that meet NDAA/TAA/Berry compliance requirements. Each supplier undergoes verification of their CAGE code, product country of origin, and documented supply chain.
- **Logistics Consolidation:** We offer federal agencies the advantage of a single point of contact for multiple product categories, simplifying procurement and reducing the administrative burden of managing multiple contracts.
- **Compliance Documentation:** We provide all compliance documentation required under FAR/DFARS, including country-of-origin certifications, NDAA Section 889 compliance statements, and full supply chain traceability.

1.5 COMPLIANCE COMMITMENT

- Manufactured in the United States or in Trade Agreements Act (TAA) designated countries.
- Free of components from manufacturers prohibited under NDAA Section 889.
- Compliant with the Berry Amendment when applicable to Department of Defense acquisitions.
- Full country-of-origin and supply chain documentation available for each product.

SECTION 2 — COMPLIANCE FRAMEWORK

2.1 NDAA COMPLIANCE — SECTION 889

ADLG ensures that no products offered in this catalog contain components or services from entities prohibited under NDAA Section 889, including Huawei, ZTE, Hytera, Hikvision, Dahua, or their subsidiaries. Each electronic product is subject to individual NDAA §889 verification and supplier declaration.

2.2 TRADE AGREEMENTS ACT (TAA)

A product complies with the TAA if it has been substantially transformed in a designated country, meaning it has been converted into a new and different commercial article with a name, character, or use distinct from the original materials or components. Mere assembly, packaging, or labeling does not constitute substantial transformation.

2.3 BERRY AMENDMENT

The Berry Amendment (10 U.S.C. § 4862) is a domestic content requirement that applies specifically to Department of Defense (DoD) acquisitions. It requires certain products to be 100% U.S. origin — from raw material to finished product.

PRODUCTS COVERED UNDER THE BERRY AMENDMENT

Important Note: The Berry standard is stricter than the Buy American Act. Under Berry, every component, raw material, and processing stage must be domestic. A glove sewn in the U.S. with imported fabric does NOT comply. A tent assembled in the U.S. with imported straps does NOT comply. The contract threshold for Berry applicability is \$150,000 or more in DoD funds.

2.4 BUY AMERICAN ACT (BAA)

- **Domestic End Product:** The product must be mined, produced, or manufactured in the United States.
- **Domestic Component Threshold:** For manufactured products, at least 60% of component cost must be U.S. manufactured (updated FAR threshold).
- **COTS Exception:** Commercially available off-the-shelf items (COTS) are exempt from the domestic component requirement.
- **Price Preference:** A 20% price preference (30% for small businesses) is applied in favor of domestic products.

4.1 SUBCONTRACTING & RESELLER MODEL

ADLG operates under a reseller/intermediary model, consolidating products from multiple manufacturers into a single, compliant supply chain for federal agencies. We focus on:

- **Verification of Compliance:** NDAA, TAA, Berry, and BAA due diligence on every product.
- **Order Consolidation:** Single purchase order for multi-manufacturer product sets.
- **Delivery Management:** Contract-compliant logistics to federal facilities.
- **FAR/DFARS Documentation:** Certificates of origin, §889 declarations, and country-of-manufacture certifications.

4.2 SUPPLIER VERIFICATION PROCESS

1. **Supplier Identity Verification:** CAGE code verification, SAM.gov registration, exclusion list review, socioeconomic certifications (SDVOSB, 8(a), HUBZone, etc.).
2. **Product Compliance Verification:** Country-of-origin certificates, TAA compliance, NDAA §889 declarations, Berry certifications, supply chain documentation.
3. **Quality & Authorization Verification:** Manufacturer authorization letters, product certifications (NIJ, MIL-STD, NSN), past performance review, delivery capability evaluation.

- **Stage 4 — Delivery:** Contract-compliant logistics.
- **Stage 5 — Federal Agency:** Receipt & inspection.

4.5 IMPORTANCE OF CAGE VERIFICATION

The CAGE Code (Commercial and Government Entity) is a unique five-character identifier assigned by the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to entities doing business with the federal government. ADLG verifies the CAGE Code of every supplier to ensure the entity is legitimate and active. CAGE Codes are publicly verifiable through the DLA CAGE Code Search system. Suppliers without a valid CAGE Code are not incorporated into our supply chain.
